Retreat Leader Biography

The Rev. Dr. David Roberts MacDonald+ PhD, is a priest of the Episcopal church. Born in Panama in 1954, he is the son of the Very Rev. Malcolm Richard MacDonald, and Frances Newton MacDonald. He saw active/reserve military service in the U.S. Army between 1977-1995, and was awarded the 'Meritorious Service Medal' (MSM) by the President of the United States for his service as a U.S. Army Chaplain (Major) during 'Desert Storm/Shield'. From 2004-2006, he was the Angus Dunn Fellow of the Diocese of Washington. In 2006 he was asked to serve as a Chaplain of Washington National Cathedral. In July of 2013 he was listed on the 'Queen's List' for appointment as a 'Commander' in the Order St. John.

His undergraduate degree is a (B.A.) in history from <u>California Polytechnic State University</u>, San Luis Obispo (1976). He holds two masters degrees, an (M.Div.) from <u>Seabury-Western Theological Seminary</u> in Evanston, Illinois (1987); As well as an (M.A.) in religious studies from the <u>University of Wales Lampeter</u>-United Kingdom (2004). In February 2007, he was awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD.) in 'Anglican Studies' from the <u>Graduate Theological Foundation</u> in South Bend, Indiana for original research and study at the <u>University of Oxford</u>. His thoughts on <u>'Theology & Creativity</u>' were published in the February/2005 '<u>Lenten Book Issue</u>' of the '<u>Living Church</u>'. His two books, '<u>The Transit of the Anglican Mind to the Maryland Colony</u>' and '<u>Padre</u>' were published in 2007. In the summer of 2008 he was asked by '<u>The Living Church</u>' to be one of their book reviewers. Later that year he was asked to be a contributor to the 'British Royal Army ~ Chaplain's Department Journal'.

David retired as rector of 'St. Luke's Episcopal Church-Sea Cliff, New York' on January 1st 2018, after 30 years ordained service in the Episcopal Church He is now a member of St. Peter the Fisherman Episcopal Church in New Smyrna Beach, Florida. He is married to Betty Wood MacDonald, and they have five children between them.
